

Addition Strategies

Plus Zero	<p>Add 0 to a number and the number stays the same.</p> $3 + 0 = 3$
Count Up +1, +2, +3	<p>Count up when adding on small numbers, such as 1, 2, or 3.</p>
Turn Around	<p>Add numbers in any order and the total stays the same.</p> $3 + 1 = 4 \quad 1 + 3 = 4$
Doubles	<p>Add the number to itself and that number doubles.</p> $2 + 2 = 4$
Doubles Plus One	<p>Double the number and add one more.</p> $2 + 3 = 2 + 2 + 1$
Tens Partners	<p>There are six sets of number pairs that make 10:</p> $\begin{array}{ccc} 10 + 0 & 9 + 1 & 8 + 2 \\ 7 + 3 & 6 + 4 & 5 + 5 \end{array}$
Plus Ten	<p>When 10 is added to a number, the tens-place digit increases by one.</p> $12 + 10 = 22$
<p>Plus Nine</p> <p>See 9. Think 10.</p> <p>See 9. Make 10.</p>	<p>To add 9 to a number, add 10 instead and jump back one.</p> <p>See $6 + 9$. Think $6 + 10 - 1$.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>To add 9 to a number, make the 9 a 10 by reducing the other addend by one.</p> <p>See $9 + 4$. Make $10 + 3$.</p>
